The Declaration

These are the Qualifications for the candidate to participate in the Election of the Muslim Council of Calgary Foundation & Districts as per Constitution and bylaws.

The Candidate will sign this declaration in the time of nomination and will be witness by the member of the election committee.

The Declaration

- Must be a Muslim, eighteen years of age or older who resides in the city of Calgary or in its vicinity.
- Meet the Membership requirement as per MAC and MCFC.
- Must be a member in good standing for the period of Six months prior to the Nomination date.
- Practice Islamic Principles in daily life and does not engage in any obvious Kabair such as shirk, ukuk of parents, drinking alcohol, fornication, usury, violence and abuse of any kind, etc.
- Is not involved in an activity that is contrary to the laws, does not have any criminal conviction or any criminal offences pending against prior to the elections. MCCF reserves the right to conduct a Police background check of all the candidates (pre & post elections).
- Is not involved in any legal action and cases against MCCF or any of its district / affiliate organizations.
- Must not be an employee of the MCCF, MAC, MCFC/CIS and this is also applicable to the immediate family (wife and un-married Children living with them).
- The directors elected will be the initial directors of the MCC Foundation and Districts, this will be considered their first term.
